A Moose Legionnaire is eligible for an elected office after he has been a member of that Moose Legion for a period of six (6) months preceding May 1st of the year of his election. He must have also completed an authorized Moose Legion Educational Conference (MLEC) within two (2) years of election. (Also pertains to current Board of Officers).

The Nominating Committee consists of the Board of Directors and the duly appointed Assistant Secretaries representing the Lodges within the jurisdiction. This applies to all current Board of Directors.
